5:10 - 5:15	Review and Vote: Budget 2022-2023.	Discussion: Budget clarification (line item 6290 Support Services Insurance) from question last meeting - insurance and benefits are being allocated to different categories this year compared to last, with more positions allocated to instructional staff vs. administrative or support staff. Separate categories for SIA and ESSER-III wages/benefits are also in use.  Jesse motions to approve the 2022-23 Budget.  → Kapil seconds the motion.  → Vote: Jesse, Deb, Matt, Kapil, Jill in favor, none opposed, Sunita (staff) abstains.
5:15 - 5:30	Board recruitment and bylaws – plan, timeline.	Board Recruitment: current members include one member with graduated students, and four with 5th graders. Ideas: recruit parents of younger children; recruit outside Emerson to build fundraising potential, but this may be challenging and is not the model most charter schools use; advertise on Emerson website / social media; recruiting grandparents, former teachers, or educational leaders in the community. Screening and interviewing applicants can be time-consuming. Timing goal: January 2023 to start process of recruitment.

	Funding update	Enrollment: 7 students have enrolled, 8 more students are looking at Emerson. Hoping to reach a goal of 120 students soon. Recruitment has been requiring a lot of individual conversations and tours per Sunita as families decide if Emerson is the right fit. Transitioning new students into a class requires some extra effort for teachers as well.  Funding: ESSER-II has been used as of last year. Rachel's position (Instructional Support Teacher) is funded for this year and three-quarters of next school year via ESSER-III; the school will fund this position for the remaining quarter of next year. SIA funding supports 100% of Jo's Instructional Coach position. Supervising EA (Ashley) is funded by the school.
